



Athletic Hall of Fame Guidelines and Nominations

The Bishop LeBlond High School Athletic Hall of Fame was initiated by the school in 2005 to recognize athletes, coaches and individuals who have made a significant positive impact on the athletic program since the high school began interscholastic athletic competition in the fall of 1970.

The Athletic Hall of Fame will hold its induction at 6 p.m. on Sunday, May 27, 2007 at Bishop LeBlond.

Guidelines and Nominations

Purpose - to recognize and honor those individuals/teams who have contributed to the promotion, growth and excellence of Bishop LeBlond athletics.

Up to three (3) individuals or teams will be inducted each year.

Individuals/teams will be selected annually during the spring and inducted during Alumni Weekend/Memorial Day Weekend.

Candidates eligible for selection can be:

- Athletes/teams with distinction
- Coaches and athletic directors
- Cheerleaders/Dancers
- Volunteers/Contributors
- Individuals having provided meritorious service

Nominations may be made by any individual or committee member and must be received at Bishop LeBlond by April 6, 2007. Inductees will be notified no later than May 1, 2007.

Qualifications for selection:

- Athlete/team, coach, cheerleader, dancer, must have completed athletic competition or service as coach/staff five years prior to selection. Athletes must have graduated from Bishop LeBlond High School. A nominated coach must have coached at LB for a minimum of four years and must no longer be coaching at Bishop LeBlond; however an individual being nominated for contributions or service may still be involved in the same or similar capacity. The selection is based on accomplishments at Bishop LeBlond only.
- Nominee must be recognized by teammates, staff, media and Bishop LeBlond as having been an outstanding athlete or contributor to Golden Eagle athletics.
- Nominee must be of outstanding character and citizenship.
- Nominee must have enhanced/fostered the development and growth of the athletic program.
- Unless deceased, nominee must be able to be present or represented by family member to accept induction.

The Bishop LeBlond Hall of Fame Committee will make the selection and final approval of the Hall of Fame Committee's recommendations will be approved by the school administration.
