The Bishop LeBlond High School Student Service Requirement

The mission of Catholic education is to proclaim the Mission of Jesus and His Church. Of prime importance in Jesus' ministry is service to others. Service may be defined as voluntarily giving assistance to someone who is in need of help. There is NO compensation for volunteer service. To fulfill LeBlond's service requirement, one may not consider helping relatives as service.

Each year students must donate the following hours of service to school, parish, or community. A total of 60 hours is necessary to graduate. Confirmation service hours will count.

Effective with the 2004-05 freshman class, yearly service hour requirements are:

Freshmen	20 hours
Sophomores	20 hours
Juniors	10 hours
Seniors	10 hours

Volunteer work in different types of service is required to fulfill the 60 hours. Students are encouraged to work on service hours consistently throughout the year. Students should turn service hour forms in to the counselor or the school office.

- Cleaning the church or school

- Serving or cantoring at Mass
- Aiding teachers in cleaning their classrooms
- Removing trash from the grounds
- Any odd jobs that need to be done

- Volunteering at any of the charitable organizations in St. Joseph
