Celebrating 50 Years

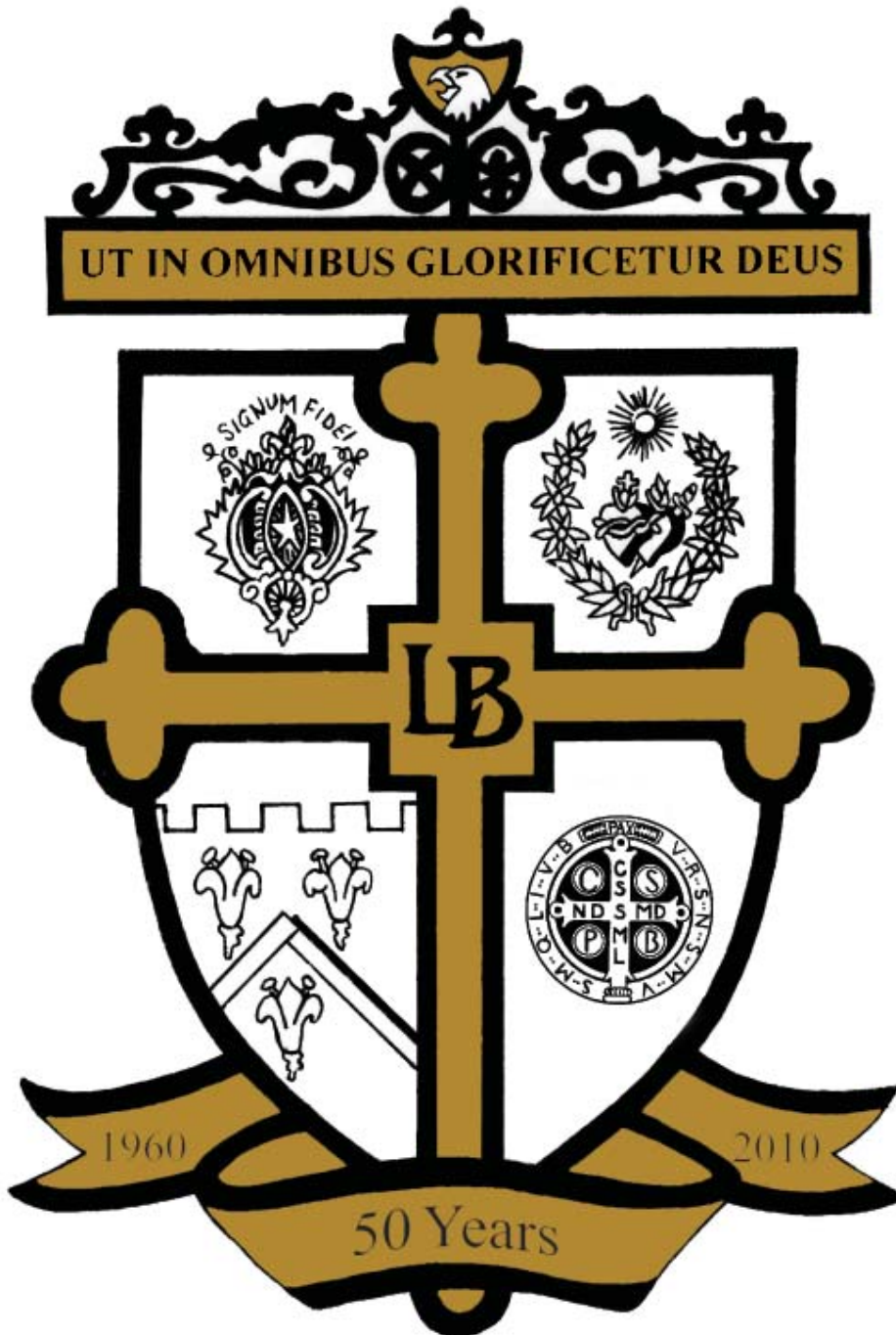
Bishop LeBlond High School was founded in 1960 as an all-girls school and the successor to the Convent of the Sacred Heart. The Benedictine sisters from Mount St. Scholastica monastery in Atchison, Kan., established the school and used the Convent of the Sacred Heart building that first year until the current location at 36th & Frederick opened in 1961.



The school was named to honor longtime St. Joseph Diocese Bishop Charles H. LeBlond who was very popular with both Catholics and non-Catholics alike.

LeBlond became co-ed in 1970 when Christian Brothers High School closed. Initial enrollment at the city's first coeducational Catholic high school was 446, with 240 girls and 206 boys. Tuition that year was \$325. The principal was Sister Mary Agnes McPhee O.S.B.

Throughout the past 50 years enrollment has risen and fallen, the eastern portion of St. Joseph has grown tremendously and we've witnessed dramatic technological change. The mission of LeBlond High School has remained constant and reflects well on the foundation built during the past 155 years by the Christian Brothers, religious of the Sacred Heart and Benedictine Sisters.

From the Principal

Dear Alumni and Friends,

As the senior class counts down their final days until graduation I marvel at how swiftly time has flown during my first year as principal. I can attest to the continued strength of the educational environment at LB, as I've personally learned a great deal in my "freshman" year at the helm.

I continue to be impressed by the commitment to our school by the parents, alumni, corporate friends and the Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph. As we prepare to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the founding of Bishop LeBlond High School I have come to recognize the strength of the foundation of generations of individuals, groups and organizations who have ensured a quality, Catholic education remains available in northwest Missouri.

Reflecting on what my predecessors, and the predecessor schools of the Convent of the Sacred Heart and Christian Brothers, faced throughout

the history of those schools helps me put our current challenges in perspective. The strength of their faith must have guided them through world wars, the Great Depression and tumultuous times and events. I can only imagine the unique disciplinary issues that arose when the CB gentlemen first arrived in the fall of 1970 and the Benedictine Sisters hosted the first co-educational Catholic high school in the city's history. Again, their faith, and thousands of prayers and rosaries offered up, must have sustained them.

When we fight the contrasting battles of skirt length for the girls and hair length for the boys, I imagine that there has always been much discussion about both. One can never be too long, and the other can never be too short.

When I think about these "problems" I can't help but determine that we are fortunate our students see the big issues as having their cell phones taken away, or getting detention for too many tardies. If

problems such as those are the main focus, then we have little to worry about compared to many of our public school counterparts.

Of course our students are blissfully unaware that the real challenges at Bishop LeBlond revolve around ensuring that our financial resources keep pace with our expenses. As careful stewards of the legacy of Catholic education in St. Joseph we must continue to find ways to provide a quality Catholic education while allowing affordable access to all families who desire it.

As you'll note in a subsequent article in this issue, our alumni and friends are once again responding to our call. In the eight weeks since our annual appeal mailing went out we have received more than \$29,000 from 180 donors with an average gift size of more than \$100. With that representing a response rate of only 4 percent of our alumni, I can't help but imagine what the results might be if even 50 percent of our alumni participated. Your gift of \$10, \$25, \$50, or \$100, when added with the gifts of

others makes a tremendous difference. Furthermore, it inspires and sustains us in our pursuit of our mission. If you've already made a gift, thank you. If not, please consider joining your classmates, siblings, parents and friends in supporting Bishop LeBlond High School. Every gift helps.

We have had much to celebrate lately.

In February our Bishop LeBlond Dance Team brought home the 2010 state championship. The team, coached by Adrienne Kastner '01 Smith, has now won four state championships in the past six years.

The Class of 2010 has six seniors who scored 31 or higher on the ACT. Matt and Mike Lierz, twin sons of Dr. Mark & Susan Ketter '80 Lierz, each scored a 31. The twins plan to split up with Matt hoping to attend either the University of Notre Dame or Harvard. Mike is interested in the University of Kansas, Creighton University, Vanderbilt or Notre Dame.

Alex Lukens, son of Dr. Matthew & Marianne Lukens, also earned a 31. He is planning to attend either the University of Missouri or Ohio State University.

Andrew Nellestein, son of Dr. Michael & JerryAnn Nellestein, earned a composite score of 32. A two-time All-State catcher, Andrew plans to play baseball at the University of

Villanova.

Juston Sanger, son of Robert '58 & Deborah Sanger, earned a composite of 33 and a perfect score of 36 on the math subtest. He plans to attend Missouri University of Science and Technology in Rolla.

ACT scores overall for the class of 2010 are considerably higher than last year. The 51 of 55 seniors (93 percent) who have taken the ACT have earned an average composite score of 24.45. That score is nearly a full two points above last year's class average of 22.6.

Tony Dudik Tapped To Lead Golden Eagles Football

Bishop LeBlond High School Principal Solon Haynes has announced that Tony Dudik will become the school's head football coach effective June 1. Dudik, the head football coach at Central High School for the past 23 years, is retiring from the St. Joseph School District at the conclusion of the 2009-10 school year.

Haynes said he was pleased to hire someone with Coach Dudik's experience and commitment to molding young people. "Tony brings an enthusiasm and passion for working with high school students in addition to a strong sense of integrity," Haynes said. "As a Catholic, he also will be a role model for our students in living a life of faith."

Dudik began as head football coach at Central in 1987 after serving there as an assistant coach for nine years. He is certified to teach business courses as well as physical education. He led the Indians to a Suburban Big 8 Conference Championship in 1995 when the team qualified for the state quarterfinals, only the second time in school history the school competed at state. He has coached numerous football players who went on to play at the Division I, Division I-AA and Division II level.

He earned his bachelor's degree from Missouri Western State University in 1978 and his master's from Northwest Missouri State University in 1984.
